



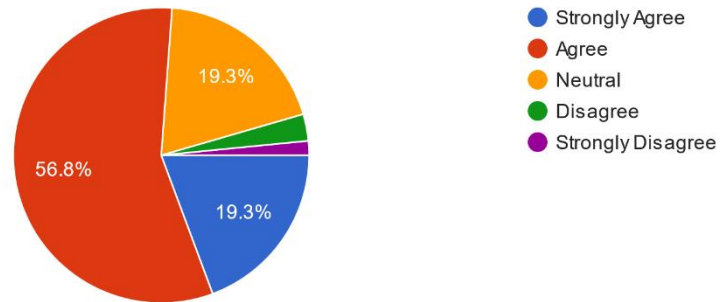

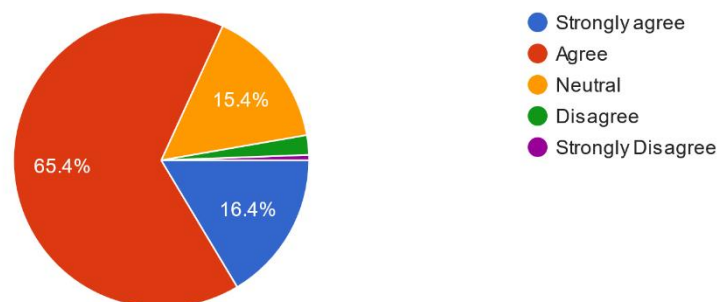
1. Curriculum is practical oriented.

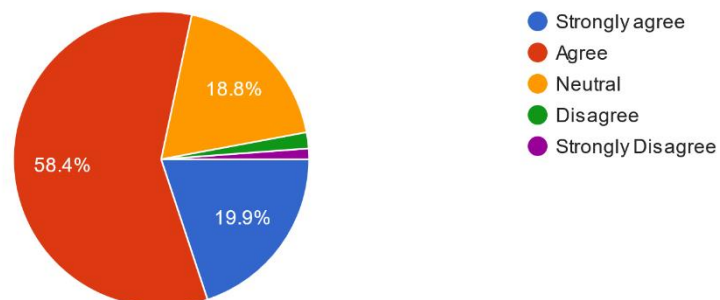
2. The sequence of the courses provided in the curriculum is appropriate.

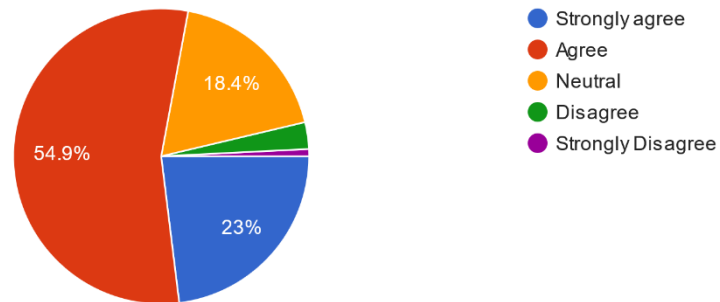
3. The syllabus of the course prescribed is relevant.

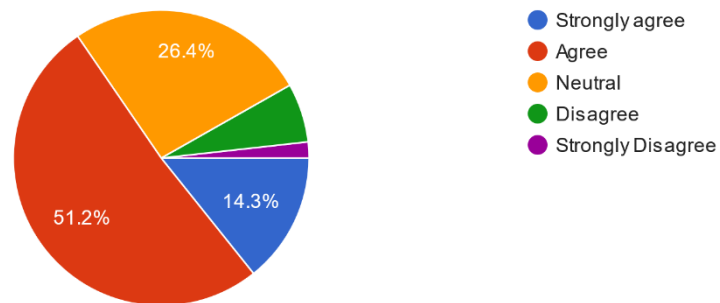
4. The text books and reference books are adequate and accessible as mentioned for the course.

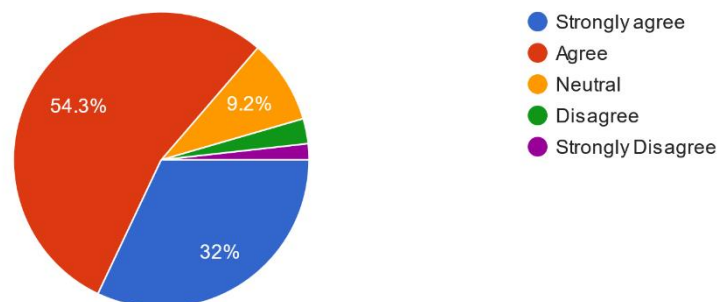
5. The curriculum is highly competitive and application oriented in relation to technology advancement.

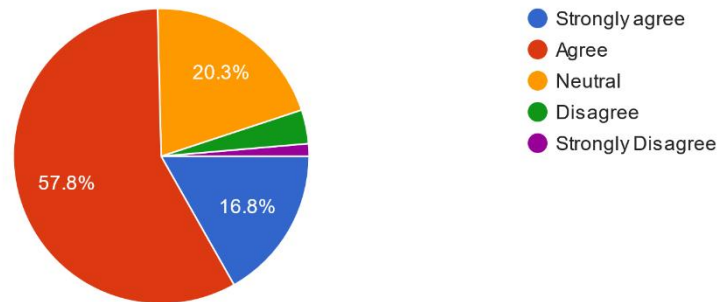
6. Your teachers are supportive to complete the syllabus

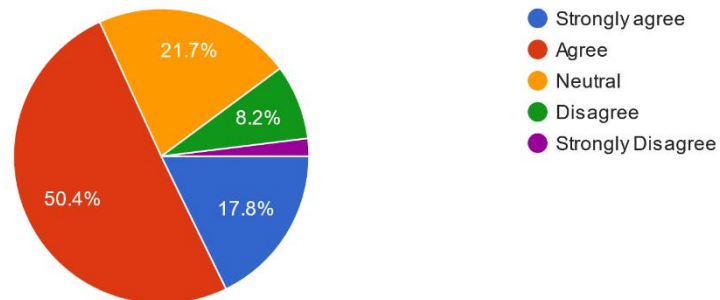
7. The allocations of credits and hours to the courses is appropriate.

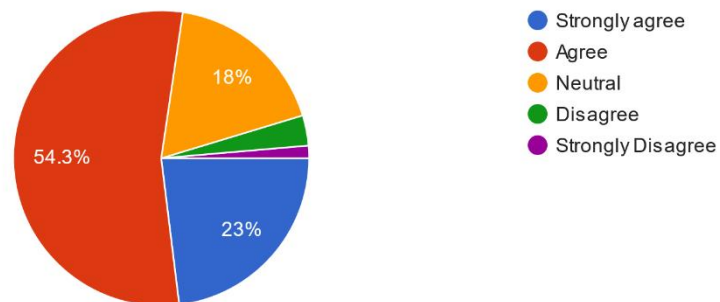
8. ICT tools are properly used by the teachers in class hour.

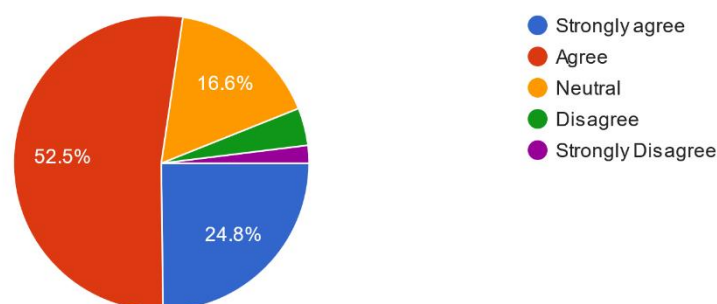
9. Internal evaluation process by the teacher is fair.

- Nearly 78% of the respondents are satisfied with the accessibility of books prescribed in the syllabus.
- About 86% of the respondents are in favor of the teachers' dedications in completing the syllabus.
- Nearly 68% of the respondents are satisfied with the ICT facilities adopted by teachers.

Different suggestions are also given by the respondents to improve the curriculum those are summarized below:

- More practical skills should be incorporate in the curriculum to develop creativity, innovative ideas, communication skills.
- More reference books and materials should be available in the college library.
- Team management and industry requirements courses to be incorporate.
- More workshops on extra -curricular activities should be organized.
- More internship and placement support are needed.
