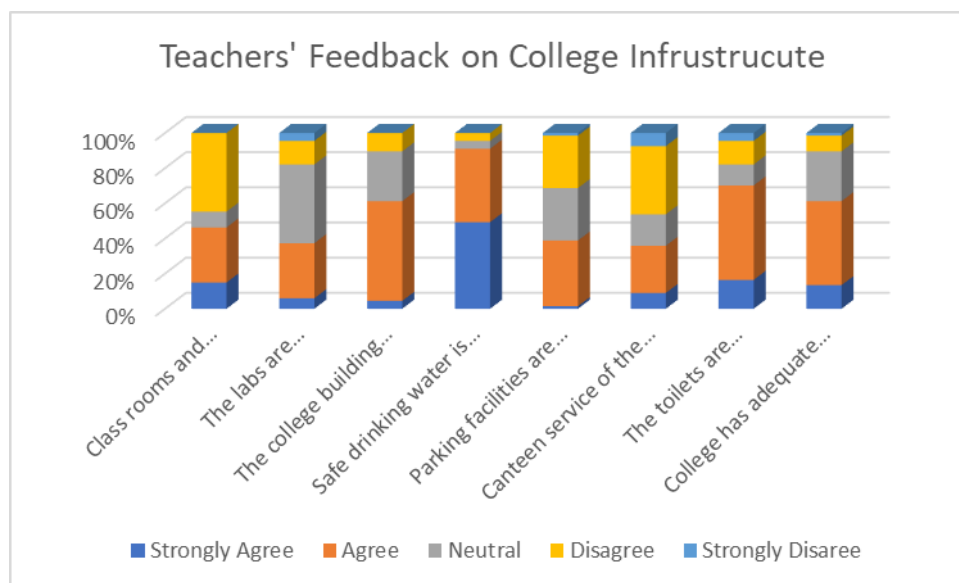

Feedback Analysis

From Teachers on College Infrastructure



As a measure of quality enhancement initiative, IQAC of Pandu College, makes it a practice to receive feedback from teachers on college infrastructure in order to augment the pace of reform and development towards better academic activity leading to qualitative improvement of all the aspects. This feedback is taken on eight parameters. These parameters are assessed on a five- point scale where they have to mark as strongly agree; agree, neutral, disagree and strongly disagree. In this process 67 responses are received.

With reference to infrastructure in the college, the teachers have given their opinions in the following way.

Nearly 40% of the teachers agreed that class rooms and furniture are adequate and are properly maintained. Nearly 35% of the faculty thinks that labs are adequately equipped. 60% of the respondents thinks that the toilets are sufficient and well maintained for faculty and students. Majority agree that safe drinking water facility is available at the college. Above 50% of the respondents are not satisfied with the canteen facility of the college.

In the analysis suggestions are also received from the respondents, those are summarized below:

- The need for better classroom lighting
- The need for bigger classrooms with facility of ICT tools.
- The need for more computers in the laboratories
- The need to improve the lab infrastructure
- Canteen facility should be improved.
