



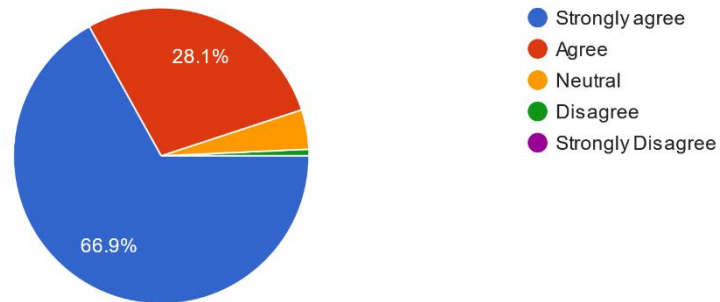

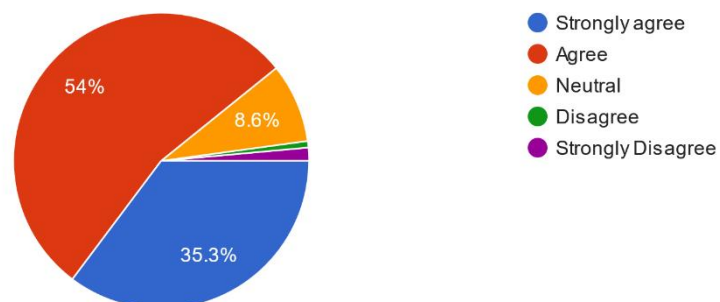
1. You feel pride of being alumni of Pandu College.

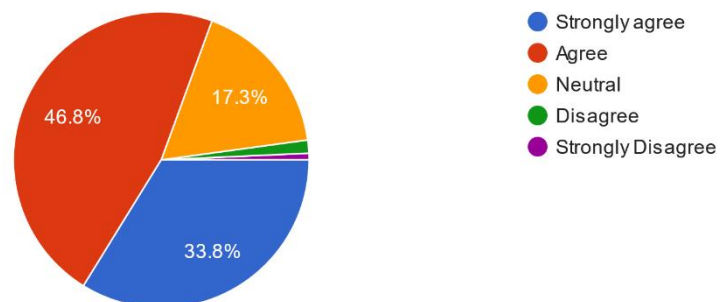
2. The syllabus of the course helped you to learn new skills

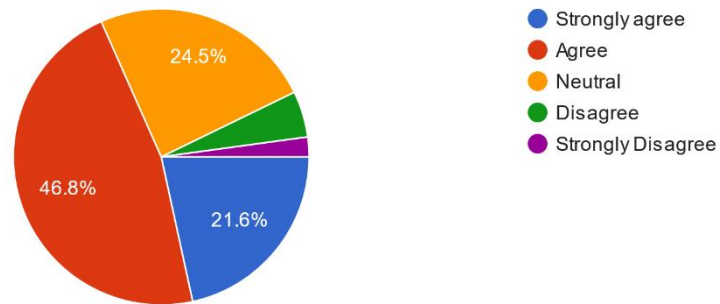
3. The syllabus was updated according to recent trends and developments.

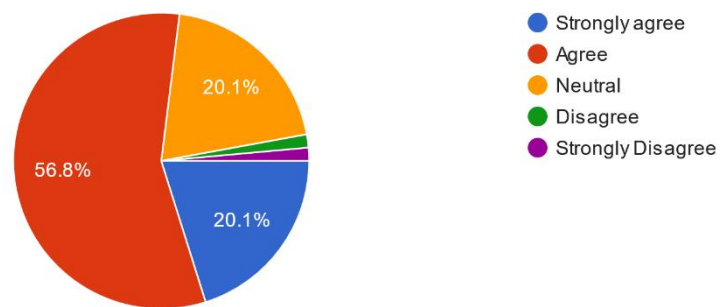
4. The syllabus is suitable for jobs related to your field.

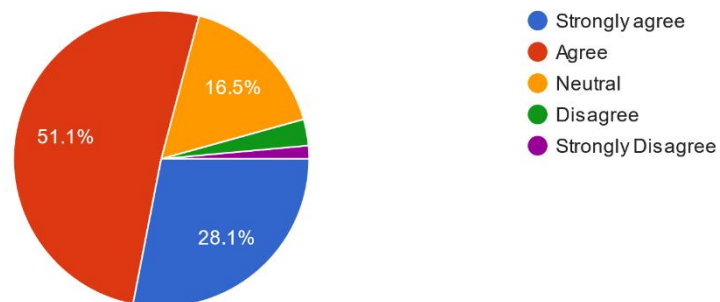
5. The course curriculum fulfilled your expectations.

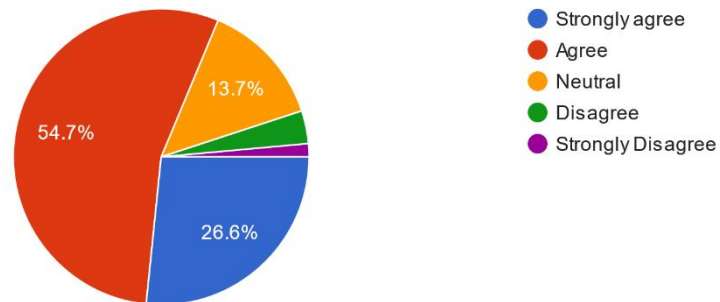
6. The syllabus has relevance to society needs.

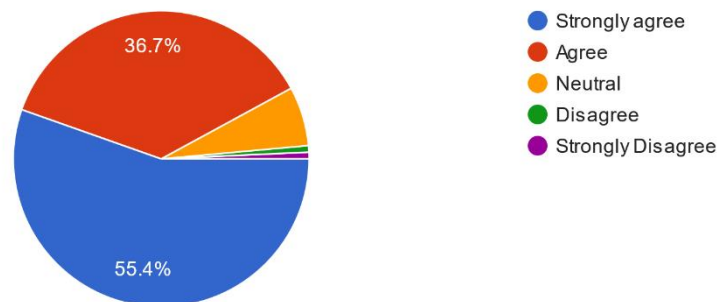
7. The assessment methods used was accurate to test the knowledge level.

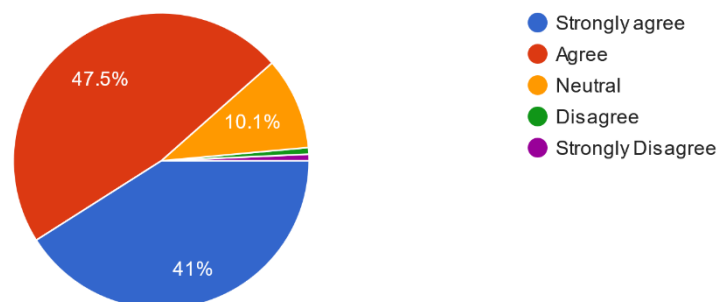
8. Your teachers were supportive in completing the syllabus and overall development of students.

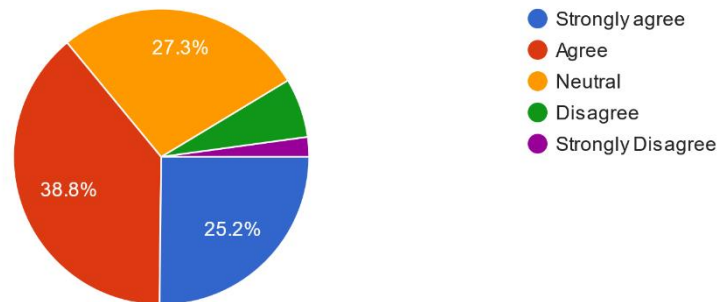
9. You are satisfied with the transparency of the evaluation system in the department.

Pandu College values the feedback of alumni on the curriculum. The basic objective of this feedback is to evaluate and analyse the relevance of syllabi, course structure and the career orientation of the curriculum. It also tries to examine the various facilities provided by the institution and the impact of the overall campus environment on their lives. A well-structured questionnaire has been used to collect the feedback. The feedback has been taken from different students across different departments.

The views and opinions of 139 alumni about the syllabus and various facilities have been analysed on a five-point likert scale. This analysis can be summarised as

- Nearly 88% of respondent alumni find the course curriculum excellent and admit that it helped them to learn new skills.
- Nearly 80% of alumni agreed the relevance of course content to the recent trend and development and the other 17% percent of alumni are neutral in this context.
- Nearly 90% of the respondents feel that the teachers were supportive in completing the syllabus and overall development of the students.
- Nearly 64% of the respondents are satisfied with the laboratory and equipment adequateness for practical exposure whereas 27% of them are neutral in this context.

Suggestions from the alumni for curriculum improvement are

- ☐ Syllabus should be designed to enable students to start their own start-ups.
- ☐ There should be more practical subjects and courses.
- ☐ Placements should be improved.
